#### **Application Process**

**Step one**: Review Dual Degree program requirements of your **home** Faculty (<u>Faculty of Arts</u> or <u>Faculty of Applied Science</u>).

**Step two:** Meet with an <u>Arts Academic Advisor</u> to discuss your goals, motivations and suitability in pursuing the Dual Degree program. Complete this application form and obtain signature from an Arts Advisor if you meet eligibility requirements. Engineering students must complete a list of your proposed Arts courses before meeting with an <u>Arts Academic Advisor</u> to discuss your goals, and academic planning.

**Step three (optional):** The <u>Engineering first-year curriculum</u> is standardized. You are welcome to book an advising appointment with an <u>Engineering Academic Advisor</u> if you would like to discuss your application or to discuss your Engineering options.

Step four: Submit your application to your home Faculty:

- Engineering students apply through <u>Engineering Student Services</u>
- Arts students apply through Arts Academic Advising Services

**Step five:** If you are accepted to the Dual Degree, you will receive official notification of admission by email from your new degree program, either the Faculty of Arts or Applied Science.
